REFLECTION PROMPTS What can I write about in my reflection?

Characters

- •How do you feel about the characters? Why? What made you feel that way?
- •Do any of the characters remind you of someone in your life? Who and how?
- What choices did the character have? What choice did they make? Why?
- Which characters change and which don't? How is character change important in the story?
- •What did you learn from character in the story?

Setting

- •Is the place important to the story? Why or why not?
- •How is the setting like another place you know?

Plot

- What do you think will happen next in the story? Why?
- •Was there a particular problem in the book? How was it solved?
- Did the book end as you expected? Why?
- •Do you have any unanswered questions? What are they?

Message/Theme

- •What is the theme of the story?
- •What does the story mean to you? Why?
- Why did the author write this story? Why do you think this?

Author

- •Did the author keep you interested? How or why?
- Have you read any of their other books? How does this compare?

Format of the text

- •How is the text structured? e.g. is it a graphic novel, novels in verse etc
- •Did the format add or take away your enjoyment of the text? Why or why not?

Making connections to other texts

- Does this text remind you of any other texts e.g. tv shows, movies, computer games? In what way?
- •How is this book different from other books you've read in this genre?
- •Is this text related to a tv show, movie or computer game? What things are the same and what things are different?

Personal connection

- •What made you choose this book from the shelf?
- •Did this text hold your interest? Why or why not?
- •How did the text make you feel?
- •Is there anything you would change in the text? Why?
- •Would you recommend this text to others? Why or why not?
- What did you learn or find interesting in what you have just read?
